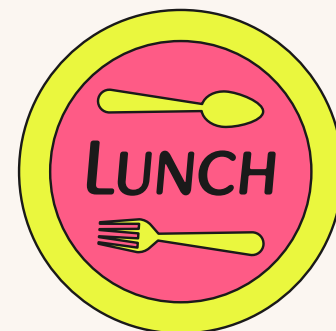

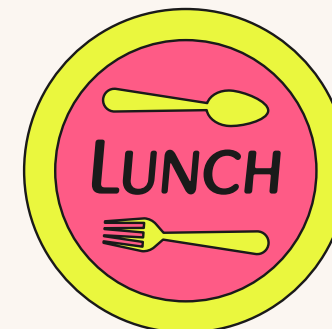

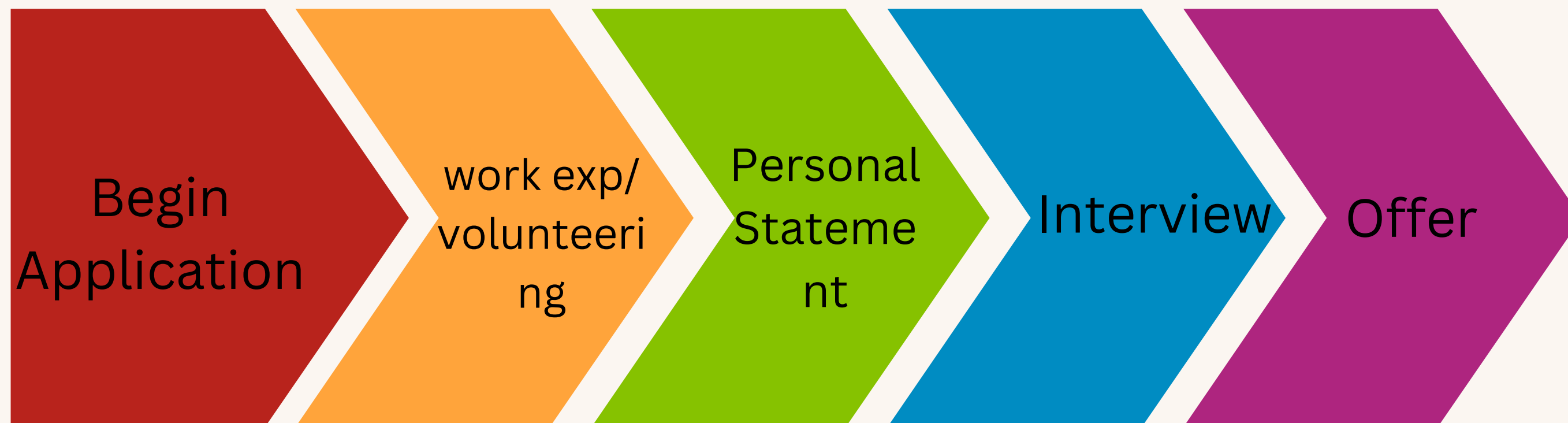
Logistics

Example extract from Student A's application before and after completing our course:

Before: I would like to become a doctor due to my love of science and my desire to help people. I have shown my interest in science through tutoring science to other students and participating in science club. I am a confident communicator and leader as demonstrated by my role as football team captain and my contributions to the school orchestra.

After: I have demonstrated my passion for medicine and science through my engagement in an array of additional lectures, courses, and research workshops in which I was able to understand various area of medicine such as interpreting ECG's, Xrays, and other medical imaging. I further explored the medical landscape through analysing opinions from 30 different doctors and understanding their opinions on the challenges and opportunities associated with their careers. Amongst these was the opinion of a cardiologist which allowed me to gain an insight into the complex nature of handling difficult patient conversations such as end-of-life consultations. I was made aware of the emotional demands this can hold and completed a medical ethics course to prepare myself for such scenarios and enhance my communication ability to accurately understand the skill of breaking bad news to patients.

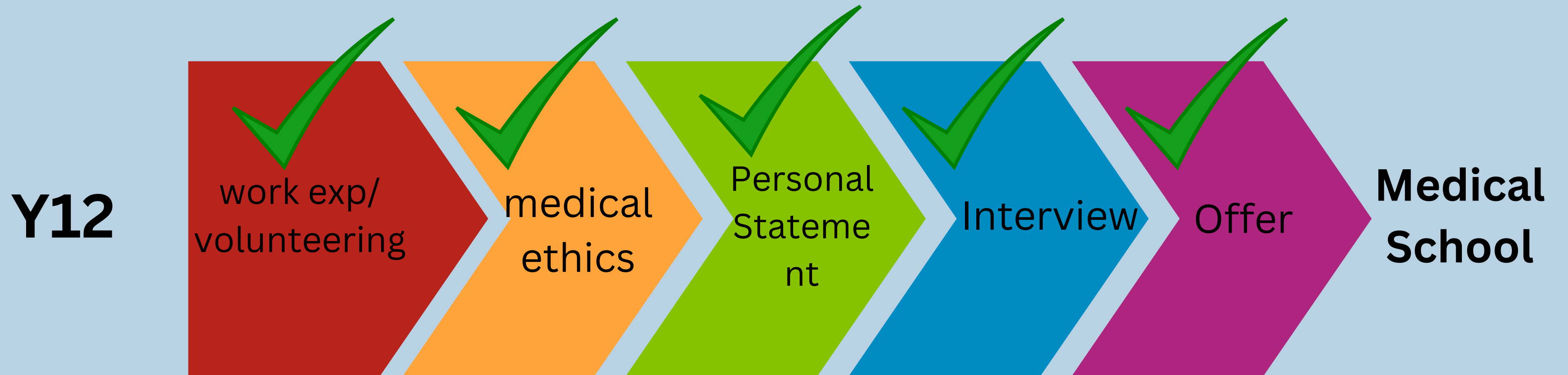
